BELGRAVIA

Pinot Gris 2009

Orange continues to impress; this wine has seriously intense flavours and an extremely long finish. Positively demands seafood.

Rating 94 Points

Sauvignon Blanc 2009

A quite tight style, with the aromas and flavours turning on citrus, herb and gooseberry, not at the tropical end; good balance.

Rating 90 Points

Apex Chardonnay 2009

Made in sotto voce style, seamless fruit and oak finely textured and balanced, stone fruit and melon as much as citrus driving the palate.

Rating 90 Points

Riesling 2009

A particularly intense riesling, with great thrust through the palate and onto the finish and aftertaste; lime, mineral and a touch of green apple; very good balance and length.

Rating 94 Points

Gewurztraminer 2009

Well made, and draws out some lychee, musk and spice flavours on the palate in particular; on retasting, ginger joins the fray. Great for Chinese food.

Rating 91 Points

Syrah 2008

Medium red-purple; an elegant, medium-bodied wine with an interplay of red fruits, spice and pepper, the palate long and fine. on retasting, ginger joins the fray. Great for Chinese food.
